## **How We Began**

he desire to give books to children of students enrolled in the GED and Adult Literacy program in 1996 was the beginning of "Storybook Christmas". In 2001 the program was expanded to include other holidays and became known as "Holidays with Books". A very generous donor contributed \$5000 and soon the program had taken on a great "Celebration" reaching further out into the Community. So today, Celebrate with Books is much more than a gift at Christmas.

We believe every child should have a book to call their own and the chance to develop a lifelong love of reading. Through the Celebrate with Books program, books are placed in the hands of children who may never have the opportunity to own their own books. The program also reaches community centers by placing small book collection where children gather.

Friends of the Scott County Public Library continue to raise funds and accept donations of books and/or money to support this great program. The friends are a 501(c)3 not-for-profit organization, and donations are tax deductible.

Remember your favorite book from childhood and the joy of reading a really good book? Children of all ages enjoy and benefit from books. Listed below are a few tips for purchasing books for children.

#### **Newborn to 6 months**

- Choose books with few or not words and simple, bold (especially black and white) pictures.
- Babies like looking at photos of human faces, especially other babies.
- Babies like hearing rhymes and songs that are often found in nursery rhymes.

#### 6 to 12 months

 Choose sturdy board books that have bright pictures, simple text and can withstand tearing and chewing.
Continue to include rhymes and songs.

#### 12 to 24 months

Choose books with repetition and predictability.
Continue to include rhymes and songs.

## 3 to 5 years

- · Choose books that you enjoyed as a child.
- Choose books that relate to your child's Worldstarting school, getting a new pet or sharing toys with a sibling.

## **School Age**

 Choose books appropriate for the child's reading level and interests.
